Online Safety Policy

Wales: NMS
20.1 - 20.6

Once Upon A Time nursery is aware of the growth of internet use and the advantages this can bring. However, it is also aware of the dangers and strives to support children, staff and families in using the internet safely.

Keeping Children Safe in Education categorises online safety into three areas of risk:

- content: being exposed to illegal, inappropriate or harmful material;
- contact: being subjected to harmful online interaction with other users; and
- conduct: personal online behaviour that increases the likelihood of, or causes, harm.”

The Designated Safeguarding Coordinator is ultimately responsible for online safety concerns. All concerns need to be raised as soon as possible to the designated officer.

Within the nursery we aim to keep children, staff and parents safe online by:

- Management reviewing all apps or games downloaded to tablets to ensure all are age appropriate for children and safeguard the children and staff
- Using nursery devices only to record/photograph in the setting. All televisions and echoes in the setting are set to child-friendly mode.
- Reporting emails with inappropriate content to the internet watch foundation (IWF www.iwf.org.uk)
- Ensuring children do not use internet devices.
- Talking to children about ‘stranger danger’ and deciding who is a stranger and who is not, comparing people in real life situations to online ‘friends’
- We abide by an acceptable use policy, ensuring staff only use the work IT equipment for matters relating to the children and their education and care. No personal use will be tolerated
